The National Ambulance Service has created a register of Defibrillators/AED (advisory External Defibrillator). You are invited to register your defibrillator with the National Ambulance Service.

The Ambulance Service will add the location of your defibrillator onto the control centre system. The chance of survival from cardiac arrest is directly linked with early defibrillation. If an emergency call requiring a defibrillator is received by the NAS control centre, we will advise the caller of the nearest available defibrillator.

Registering your defibrillator with the Emergency Medical Service is recommended by the *task force report on sudden cardiac death 2006* and is recommended by suppliers of defibrillators.
